Take ordinary texture and amplify it to outrageous proportions for drama.

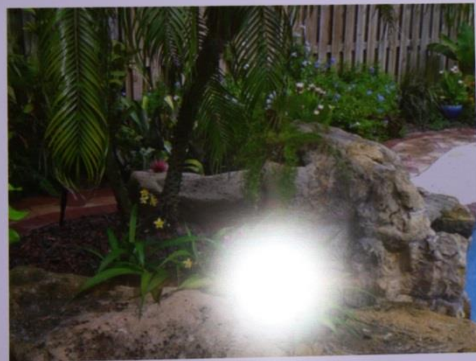
Consider adding layers with different forms.

Palmetto Angel

Leave stem ²⁻⁴

Remove all split stems on ends

Length of middle fond about 19 inches plus 7 to 8 inches
= 26' to 28'

Gradate up to about 12 inches in center

7 to 8 inches for the curl

Cut top curls shorter 7 to 10"

Gradate up the sides with fonds turn in, out, sideways if possible. It will naturally turn when the clips are removed.

Find small palms for the wings. 10" x 7" with 3" stem

- After it dries in a week or two, remove the clips and leave a few more days for the fonds to turn. Then spray paint. gold, silver, red, green, blue or leave natural (buy paint at Home Depot or Lowe's which is much cheaper than craft stores). Spray several times in light layers
- Use a thin wire to wrap wings together
- Purchase neck decor. If you don't want seasonal use greens or lace ribbon.
