Pressed Flowers/foliage in the microwave!
Flatten your flower/foliage with your fingers; perhaps remove a large stem. Experience will show you what works and what doesn't.
Layer your flower/foliage: plate, paper towel, flower/foliage, paper towel, plate—a flower sandwich. Microwave 20 seconds, check. Additional 20 seconds if needed.
Again, experience teaches.
