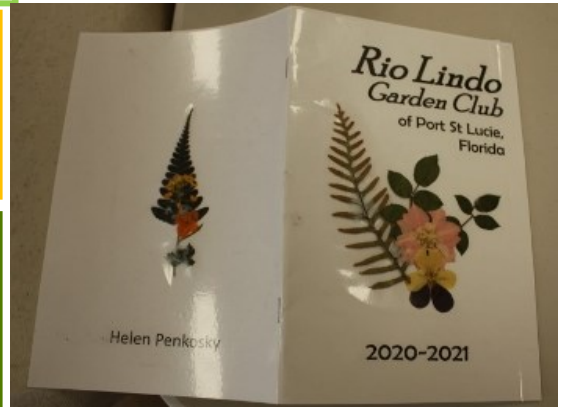

Using Your Microwave to Dry Flowers & Foliage

Flatten materials with your hands. Remove large stems. Make a flower sandwich using layers of paper towels between plant materials on a paper plate. Mexican heather flowers and foliage dry well. Orchids do not. Use the microwave in short intervals to exact moisture. Small flowering weeds, ferns and Bougainvillea flowers dry and press well.
