Dry Flowers & Foliage-

Using a Microwave- 30 seconds intervals

Flatten materials with your hands. Remove large stems. Make a flower sandwich using paper towels between plant material on a paper plate. Orchids don't dry well. Mexican heather flowers & foliage do. Consider pentas, bougainvillea and ixora. Separate the petals from the flower and stem if necessary. Thick pieces will not cover properly. Bring Elmers glue and toothpicks.
