Remove all the soil around the plant, hose it down.

Then trim the roots shorter.

Set the plant in the soil, but not real deep.



Brace up the plant until it becomes stable on its own.

Trim down the branches of the plant. Don't worry – it'll grow back.

Remove the braces when the plant becomes stable.
